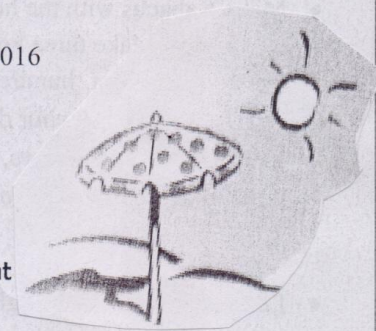

HYGIENE

- ❖ Brush your teeth twice a day

- Make an abacus with the help of a toothpaste box, cover it with coloured paper and decorate it. Make three holes at equal distance from each other. Place three sticks in the holes to represent 'hundred', 'tens' and 'ones'.

- Make cut outs of flowers, animals, birds, vegetables, fruits etc. (as many as you can)
Note:- cut outs must be made by the used materials like old newspaper, cartons, socks, old clothes etc.
- Learn any Hindi and English rhymes of your choice. (Parents kindly help your ward to learn these rhymes).
- Writing practice (one page daily) Hindi/English.
