



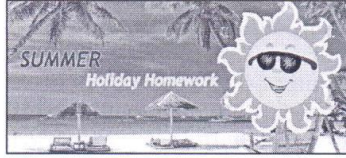

2. Based on your reading write about the characters in the story.
3. Maintain dictionary of tough words based on your reading of novels.

### MATHEMATICS

1. Do Revision of whole class work in practice copy.
2. Collect the data of the population of any ten states and round off them nearest thousand , ten thousand, lakh, ten lakh and crore.
3. Write the names of any ten famous mathematicians.
4. Measure the dimensions of some objects ( eg. Table, door, garden, cricket pitch, badminton court etc) from your surroundings and calculate their perimeters as well as areas and then show the information collected by you on a chart paper with small size pictures of objects.
5. Learn and write Table from 11 to 20.
6. Learn and write Prime number between 01 to 200.
7. Draw at least 10 geometrical shapes and write their names.
8. List all numbers which are rounded off to the nearest ten as 240.
9. Write 10 interesting facts related to Mathematics.

**Note : Do few extra questions from any other Mathematics book.**

### Social science

1. Prepare a collage depicting pictures of animals tools and human life during stone age (on chart).
2. Draw Conventional Symbols which are internationally accepted and used on maps. (on chart)
3. Make a model of globe using plastic ball depicting countries and oceans on it.
4. Name the following by consulting atlas (using A4 size sheet.)
  - a. Five countries through which equator passes.
  - b. Five countries through which tropic of cancer passes.
  - c. Five countries through which prime meridian passes.
6. MAP EXPLORER complete lesson 7,8,9 ,10,23 ,24 ,25and 26 in book only.

### SCIENCE

1. Revise the chapters taught in class and learn new terms and words by following the rule of look-cover-say-check –write.
2. Read and make a report of the diet related problems that the people are facing these days due to change in work patterns.
3. Do the activity 5 given on page number 21 in the textbook and bring the made paper fabric.
4. Make a kitchen garden by using the waste materials available at home.
5. Compare the food habits of people living in your state and four other neighboring states. Make a table in practical notebook noting down the staple diet of at least 7 states of India.
  - Find out which vegetables and fruits are grown in that area. Find out what people normally eat in that area. Write your findings in your practical notebook.
